#### **Ticketing & Admission**

- Bull Gator Deck members may enter through the Skybox Tower Lobby entrance located on the west side of the stadium, directly across from the Stephen C.
   O'Connell Center. The entrance says "Bull Gator / Suite Levels 6 & 7." Tickets will be scanned at the entrance and each person with a ticket will be issued a wristband. Bull Gator Deck members will take the elevators to the second level. At the end of the game, you may exit via the elevators or the stairwells.
- All individuals entering the Bull Gator Deck must have a Bull Gator Deck ticket for admission. This includes children and grandchildren of Bull Gator Deck members and/or guests.
- Once inside Ben Hill Griffin Stadium, all attendees are free to move about the stadium. If you wish to exit the Bull Gator Deck and enter the main concourse, you will need your wristband and ticket to re-enter the Bull Gator Deck.
- Bull Gator Deck tickets are only valid for the Bull Gator Deck.
- According to the rules and regulations set forth by the Southeastern Conference (SEC) and the University of Florida, no ticket holder may exit and re-enter the stadium unless he or she possesses a valid, un-scanned ticket.

#### **Conduct**

- Bull Gator Deck members are requested to respect the rights of other members and ensure that all activities in the Bull Gator Deck are conducted in a thoughtful and courteous manner. The Bull Gator Deck may not be used for any unlawful purpose.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult AT ALL TIMES in the Bull Gator Deck.
- Current Gators student-athletes and their family members are NOT permitted to be guests in the premium areas.

The UAA, Gator Boosters and Gator Hospitality reserve the right to ask a guest to leave at any time if they are engaged in dangerous or disruptive behavior.

#### **Game Day Staff**

- All premium areas will be staffed with our FANGINEER™ game day staff.
   FANGINEERS™ are extensions of Gator Hospitality, serving as liaisons between
   Gator Hospitality management staff, UAA personnel, Gator Boosters, Bull Gator
   Deck members and catering. FANGINEERS™ can be identified as staff members
   wearing a grey Gator Hospitality polo and a lime green lanyard.
- FANGINEERS™ will also be stationed throughout the Bull Gator Deck to assist you with whatever you need on game day.

#### **Catering**

- Gator Boosters, Inc. and the University Athletic Association will provide the following on game day:
  - A rotating buffet catered by Centerplate Catering from 90 minutes prior to kickoff until five minutes remaining in the 3rd Quarter.
  - Fountain sodas, tea, and water.

#### Alcohol

- Beer and wine is available for purchase in the Bull Gator Deck from gate opening until the conclusion of the 3rd Quarter.
- State and local laws and university rules regarding the use, possession, and
  consumption of alcohol will be strictly enforced. Intoxication by Bull Gator Deck
  members or; provision of or allowing access to alcohol by minors or to
  individuals who appear intoxicated by the Bull Gator Deck member; other
  violations by Bull Gator Deck members can result in the immediate ejection from
  the stadium.

### **Smoking Policy**

• Effective July 1, 2010, the University of Florida is a TOBACCO FREE CAMPUS. This policy will be strictly enforced as mandated by the university. Smoking will not be permitted anywhere on campus including all areas of the Bull Gator Deck.

#### **Hours of Operation**

• The Bull Gator Deck will open 90 minutes prior to kickoff and close at the conclusion of the game.

#### **Emergency Medical Procedures**

 Medical personnel are available throughout the stadium. Should a medical emergency arise, please notify Shari Brendemuhl at the Bull Gator Deck desk immediately.

#### **Prohibited Items**

- Please do not bring any large bags, backpacks, umbrellas, camera cases, strollers, etc. into the stadium. All items brought into Ben Hill Griffin Stadium are subject to search.
- Deck members assume the risk of bringing any valuables into the premium areas and are kindly encouraged not to do so. The UAA, Gator Boosters and Gator Hospitality will not be held responsible for any personal items left in the premium areas.

#### Fire Alarms

• Should a fire alarm sound during the game, please exit the Bull Gator Deck and proceed to one of the stairwells. Do not use the elevators.

#### **Gator Sportshop**

 There are two Gator Sportshops located in Ben Hill Griffin Stadium. One is located at Gate 18, inside the stadium at the southwest corner. The other is located near Gate 8 at the northeast corner of the stadium. Both Gator Sportshops are accessible from inside and outside the stadium gates.


