GENERAL CONDITIONS OF INVITATIONS TO BID

1. PREPARATION OF BIDS

Bids will be prepared in accordance with the following:

- Our enclosed Bid forms are to be used in submitting your bid.
- All information required by the Bid form shall be furnished. The bidder shall print or type his name and manually sign the schedule and each continuation sheet on which any entry is made.
- Unit prices shall be shown and where there is an error in extension of price, the unit price shall govern.
- Proposed delivery time must be shown and shall include Sundays and holidays.
- Bidder will not include federal taxes nor State of Alabama sales, excise, and use taxes in bid prices as the City is exempt from payment of such taxes. An exemption certificate will be signed where applicable upon request.
- Bidders shall thoroughly examine the drawings, specifications, schedule, instructions and all other contract documents.
- Bidders shall make all investigations necessary to thoroughly inform themselves regarding plant and facilities for delivery of material and equipment as required by the bid conditions. No plea of ignorance by the bidder of conditions that exist or that may hereafter exist as a result of failure or omission on the part of the bidder to make the necessary examinations and investigations, or failure to fulfill in every detail the requirements of the contract documents, will be accepted as a basis for varying the requirements of the City or the compensation to the vendor.

2. DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES

3. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

4. REJECTION OF BIDS

- The City may reject a bid if:

 - The bid is conditional, except that the bidder may qualify his bid for acceptance by the City on an "all or none" basis, or a "low item" basis. An "all or none" basis bid must include all items upon which bids are invited.
- The City may, however, reject all bids whenever it is deemed in the best interest of the City. The City may also waive any minor informalities or irregularities in any bid.

7. CLARIFICATIONS OR OBJECTION TO BID SPECIFICATIONS

If any person contemplating submitting a bid for this contract is in doubt as to the true meaning of the specifications or other bid documents of any part thereof, he may submit to the Purchasing Agent on or before five (5) days prior to scheduled opening a request for clarification. All such requests for information shall be made in writing and the person submitting the request will be responsible for its prompt delivery. Any objection to the specifications and requirements as set forth in this bid must be filed in writing with the Purchasing Agent on or before five (5) days prior to scheduled opening.

8. DISCOUNTS

(a) Bidders may offer a cash discount for prompt payment; however, such discounts shall NOT be considered in determining the lowest net cost for bid evaluation purposes. Bidders are encouraged to reflect cash discounts in the unit prices quoted.

9. SAMPLES

SPECIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS**LOCATIONS:**

This Invitation to Bid is for Ground Maintenance at seventy-three (73) City of Tuscaloosa locations. The location addresses are listed in the Bid Submissions pages (pgs. 7-12). Diagrams/photos follow the Bid Submissions pages.

The City reserves the right to add or remove locations from this list through the life of the contract. If locations are added, awarded bidder agrees to offer pricing for added location that is comparable to similar locations on this list.

MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. The successful bidder(s) shall provide all labor, materials, tools, transportation, equipment, license, insurance, and anything else necessary to perform the following at the above water tank and booster station locations:
 - Cut grass
 - Trim hedges and shrubs
 - Remove all vines/weeds/etc. Growing on both inside and outside of fences
 - Remove all trash debris, grass clippings, etc. from the areas specified
2. Mowing of all lawn areas shall be performed no less than once every two weeks during the growing season.
3. All locations will be policed and fences maintained once every two weeks during the off season. All locations will be visited at least 26 times a year unless noted otherwise.
4. String trimming around shrubbery, fences, building walls or any other fixtures shall be done in conjunction with each mowing.
5. Mechanical edging at the back of curbs along sidewalks shall be done no less than one per month but may be required with each mowing if growing conditions require.
6. Manual weeding around shrubbery or in landscaped areas shall be done on an “as needed” basis but no less than one per month.
7. The use of herbicide to control weeds shall be permitted; however, dead vegetation shall be removed as soon as it is obvious the herbicide has been effective.
8. All weeds shall be removed from joints or cracks in concrete or asphalt paved areas and along fences or building walls as needed no less than one per month.
9. Unwanted vegetation such as vines or tree seedlings shall be removed from shrubbery and or landscaped areas as needed or as soon as it is visible.
10. Weeds, vines, or any other undesirable vegetation shall be removed and prevented from re-growing along or upon building walls.
11. The grounds maintenance contractor shall remove all litter, leaves, debris or trash from within and upon the work area at the time of each mowing cycle.
12. The grounds maintenance contractor shall be responsible for the proper disposal of all litter, grass clippings, leaves, tree waste or any other material found within or upon the work site.
13. All fences shall be kept free of weeds, vines, seedling trees or any other unwanted vegetation.
14. Outside Fence line should be cut no less than 48-inches in width.
15. Any Issues that may prevent you from your requirements need to be documented and reported.
16. Any damaged property must be documented and reported.
17. Successful bidder(s) shall promptly report any incidents of damage resulting from the maintenance of any area, or of any damage that may have resulted from the actions of others.
18. Successful bidder shall invoice the City one time per month along with attached monthly grass cutting report.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

The contractor shall secure and maintain through the duration of this contract, insurance in such amounts as may be necessary to protect the interest of the City against hazards or risks of losses hereinafter specified. Such insurance shall be with companies doing business by agent in the City of Tuscaloosa in amounts to be approved by City.

The Certificate of Insurance shall contain a provision that not less than ten (10) days written notice shall be given to the City before any policy or coverage is cancelled. The insurance coverage shall include a minimum of:

- A. Workers Compensation Insurance in an amount as required under the laws of the State of Alabama. In the event any work is sublet (with the consent of the City Of Tuscaloosa), the contract shall require the subcontractor similarly to provide Workman's Compensation Insurance for all of the latter's employees.
- B. Public General Liability Insurance, written in comprehensive form, that protects the Contractor and the City against claims arising from injuries to members of the public, City employees, or damage to property of others arising out of an act or an act or omission to act of the Contractor, or any of its agents, employees, or subcontractors. The limit of liability shall not be less than \$300,000 combined single limits.
- C. Property Insurance which shall include damage to the property of the City Of Tuscaloosa in an amount not less than \$300,000.00.
- D. The City Of Tuscaloosa, its officers, agents, and employees shall be named as additional insured under the policies in subparagraphs B & C and so identified in the Certificate of Insurance. The Contractor shall furnish the City certificates of such insurance, to serve as satisfactory proof, prior to signing of contract.
