RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION SELECTING KREBS ENGINEERING, INC. FOR
CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA
MARTIN SPUR WATER TANK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
(A18-0571)

WHEREAS, the City of Tuscaloosa issued a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) to determine the interest or non-interest in the qualifications of firms to provide professional engineering services for the City of Tuscaloosa Martin Spur Water Tank Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, firms were notified in the RFP that the City requires the services of a professional firm which has the knowledge, experience and expertise to perform the services as requested in the RFP; and,

WHEREAS, City staff members evaluated and graded each response according to a numerical and pass/fail grading system as set forth in the RFP; and,

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2018, the evaluation panel recommended to the City of Tuscaloosa Projects Committee selection of Krebs Engineering, Inc. to provide the required scope of services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUSCALOOSA as follows:

1. That subject to negotiation of fair and reasonable compensation, Krebs Engineering, Inc. is hereby selected to provide the abovementioned scope of services related to professional engineering services.
2. That the Office of the City Attorney is directed to begin contract negotiations with Krebs Engineering, Inc. to establish a scope of services and a not-to-exceed contract amount based upon the firm’s hourly rate and in conformity with existing budget amounts.
3. Upon review and approval by Projects Committee, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the firm of Krebs Engineering, Inc. for the Martin Spur Water Tank Improvements Project engineering services, and the City Clerk is authorized to attest the same.
