Mayor Craft stated they were working on a bond issue at this time and that Rocky Mountain Road was one of the areas they were looking at for City sewage.

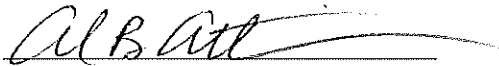
