ORDINANCE NO. 1708

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA TO DESIGNATE A \$0.35 PER MONTH FEE PER ACCOUNT ON THE CITY WATER BILL TO BE USED FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S RECYCLING PROGRAM.

SECTION I: The City Council of the City of Talladega, Alabama is committed to protecting the environment and the welfare and safety of the public. The City Council also realizes that a viable recycling-green initiative is an indicator of the overall quality of life of the community.

SECTION II: The City Council in order to secure funding for management of an efficient and effective recycling City-wide program, for adequate recycling facilities, for advertisement and recycling education of its citizens and to provide matching funds for recycling grant programs, does hereby set forth a \$0.35 per month fee per account on City water bills to be set aside and used specifically for maintaining, operating and improving the City's recycling program.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
