The City Council of the City of Oxford, Alabama, met in Regular Session in the Oxford City Hall of the City of Oxford, Alabama, on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at approximately 6:34 o'clock p.m. Council President Spurlin called the meeting to order.

Ron Allen, City Attorney, was present.

Alan Atkinson, City Clerk, was present.

Pastor Greg Ford, Grace Baptist Church, prayed the Invocation.

Council President Spurlin led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

## APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council President Spurlin stated each member of the Council had previously received a copy of the minutes of the April 11, 2023, meeting. Council Member Henderson made a motion that the minutes be approved as presented. The motion was seconded by Council Member Waits.

Council President Spurlin called for any comments or questions; there being none, on roll call the votes of the Council were as follows: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none; abstentions: Council Member Gardner. The motion carried.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Ordinance No. 2023-09 – Ordinance adopting the State Sales Tax Holiday for 2023 (July 21-23)

Council Member Gardner made a motion for the unanimous consent of the Council for the immediate consideration of Ordinance Number 2023-09. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hubbard; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Gardner, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none. The motion carried.

Unanimous consent of the Council having been given for the immediate consideration of Ordinance Number 2023-09, Council Member Henderson made a motion to approve Ordinance Number 2023-09. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hubbard; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Gardner, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none. The motion carried and Ordinance Number 2023-09 was approved.

Council Member Waits made a motion to add to the Consent Agenda, Resolution Number 2023-60, a resolution approving a Changer Order Oxford Recreation Complex (Choccolocco Park) Renovations and Additions for the Signature Softball Locker Rooms in the total amount of \$28,260.00 and Resolution Number 2023-61, a resolution revoking the moratorium on the further issuance of previously unlicensed mobile food unit operators in the city. The motion was seconded by Council Member Henderson; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Gardner, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none. The motion carried.

Phillip Morrison addressed the Council and stated that the City meant a lot to him and thanked them for saving his life and his arm.
