**HPC-02-24** Nathan Gerdau petitions for a Certificate of Appropriateness for an addition on the primary structure located at 17 Sherwood Drive in the Sherwood Drive Historic District. (Council District 4).

**HPC-03-24** Paul and Angie Moreton petition for a Certificate of Appropriateness to construct a carport on the property located at 1 Pinehurst in the Pinehurst Historic District. (Council District 4).
