MEMORANDUM

November 3, 2023

TO: SEC Courtside Seat Ticket Holders

RE: Basketball Courtside Seating

We look forward to the 2023-24 college basketball season and appreciate your support of SEC basketball.

Fans, coaches, administrators and student-athletes share a mutual commitment and responsibility to provide a safe and respectful competitive environment. Courtside seating provides the privilege to be close to the action, but with that privilege comes a higher level of expectation for you to conduct yourself appropriately before, during, and after each game.

The SEC has a zero-tolerance policy for any individual who engages in improper conduct at a basketball game in an SEC venue. Examples of improper conduct include (but are not limited to):

- Directing profane, inappropriate or threatening remarks towards a game participant or official;
- Making unwarranted physical contact with a game participant or official;
- Throwing an object or walking onto the playing court; or
- Disrupting the competition or experience of other fans.

In addition, while you are permitted to stand briefly and spontaneously cheer in reaction to an exciting play, the rules governing bench decorum for student-athletes and coaches also apply to your conduct. These rules prohibit you from standing for a prolonged time or moving away from your seat during game action.

It is your responsibility to fulfill the heightened expectations governing courtside fans. Game officials have the authority to instruct event management to remove from the arena or relocate to another seat any individual who fails to meet the expectations for courtside fans. In addition to being removed from a courtside seat, per NCAA rules, the home team may be assessed a technical foul due to inappropriate fan behavior and your ticket privileges may be revoked.

Every person using your courtside tickets is subject to these policies and you are obligated to make them aware of the expectations presented in this memorandum.

Hours of Operation

- The Courtside Club will open 60 minutes prior to tip-off and will close at the conclusion of the game.

Ticketing & Admission

- Courtside Club members should enter Exactech Arena through the Administration Gate located in the northeast corner, closest to the parking lot. The entrance says “Administration.” Guests will proceed through the metal detector screening process, tickets will be scanned and Courtside Club members will be provided with credentials and escorted to the arena floor.
- If you wish to enter the main concourse, you will need to show your lanyard for re-entry to the courtside lounge and seating areas.
- According to the rules and regulations set forth by the Southeastern Conference (SEC) and the University of Florida, no ticket holder may exit and re-enter the arena unless he or she possesses a valid, un-scanned ticket.

Prohibited Items

- Please do not bring any large bags, backpacks, umbrellas, camera cases, strollers, etc. into the arena. All items brought into Exactech Arena are subject to search.
- Club members assume the risk of bringing any valuables into the club areas and are kindly encouraged not to do so. The UAA, Gator Boosters and Gator Hospitality will not be held responsible for any personal items left in the club areas.

Conduct

- Courtside guests are to abide by the rules and regulations provided by
- Club members are requested to respect the rights of other club members and ensure that all activities in the club area are conducted in a thoughtful and courteous manner.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult AT ALL TIMES in Exactech Arena.
- Current Gators student-athletes and their family members are NOT permitted to be guests in the premium areas.

The UAA, Gator Boosters and Gator Hospitality reserve the right to ask a guest to leave at any time if they are engaged in dangerous or disruptive behavior.

Game Day Staff

- The Courtside Seats and Club Lounge will be staffed with our FANGINEER™ game day staff. FANGINEERS™ are extensions of Gator Hospitality, serving as liaisons between Gator Hospitality management staff, UAA personnel, Gator Boosters, club members and catering. FANGINEERS™ can be identified as staff members wearing a grey Gator Hospitality polo. FANGINEERS™ will be stationed at all Courtside Club entrances to assist you with whatever you need on game day.

Catering

- Gator Boosters, Inc. and the University Athletic Association will provide the following food and beverage catered by Centerplate Catering on game day:
 - A rotating buffet from gates open until the end of half time.
 - A hot dog and snack station from the middle of the first half until the conclusion of the game.
 - Sodas, tea, and water.

Alcohol

- Beer and wine are available free of charge in the Courtside Club from gate opening until the 12 minute mark in the second half.
- State and local laws and university rules regarding the use, possession, and consumption of alcohol will be strictly enforced. Intoxication by club members or; provision of or allowing access to alcohol by minors or to individuals who appear intoxicated by the club member; other violations by club members can result in the immediate ejection from the arena.

Emergency Medical Procedures

- Medical personnel are available throughout the arena. Should a medical emergency arise, please notify a FANGINEER™, Gator Hospitality staff, or Gator Boosters staff.

Smoking Policy

- Effective July 1, 2010, the University of Florida is a TOBACCO FREE CAMPUS. This policy will be strictly enforced as mandated by the university. Smoking will not be permitted anywhere on campus including all areas of Exactech Arena.
