- a) Food assistance: Tuesday 12pm-6pm, Thursday 12pm-2pm, & Friday 12pm-2pm
- b) Come in to the market and pick your food items from our client choice shelves. Income qualified households may choose food once per month. Please bring your ID for each visit.
- c) This agency receives a significant number of requests for assistance, and sometimes that means there are more people seeking services than can be accommodated at a given time. You *may* be placed on a waitlist.

 - a) Food assistance: midday meals delivered on a daily or continuous basis
 - b) Telephone application required for approval
 - c) Minimum payment required for assistance
 - d) Requires photo ID, social security card, proof of income, proof of power bill
 - e) Must be homebound & unable to prepare meals independently
