RULES & REGULATIONS

- Members are asked to familiarize themselves and their guests with all rules and guidelines, policies and procedures applicable to the club and ensure that their guests comply with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, policies and procedures. Members will be held responsible for the actions and behaviors of their guests regardless of member's presence on game day.
- 2. A ticket for the club is required for all individuals regardless of age.
- Children must be chaperoned at all times and are not permitted to roam
 the club level or coliseum without supervision. Members and guests are
 responsible for the behavior of minors using their ticket. Behaviors such as
 running, ball-throwing and other horseplay is not permitted. The safety of all
 guests, especially children, is our main concern.
- 4. All members and guests are requested to respect the rights of other members and guests to ensure that all activities conducted in the club area are done so in a thoughtful and courteous manner.
- 5. Smoking is prohibited at all times and in all locations on the campus of Mississippi State University, including indoor and outdoor athletics venues and facilities. For the purposes of this policy, "smoking" means inhaling, exhaling, burning, carrying, or possessing any lighted product, including cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco and any other lit products, and the use of electronic cigarettes or similar devices.
- Video recording equipment and video recording is prohibited in Humphrey Coliseum.
- 7. Ticket Purchaser agrees that the University shall not be liable for personal injury, loss, or damage to personal property of Ticket Purchaser or of Ticket Purchaser's guests occurring in Humphrey Coliseum, including the club seating area. Ticket Purchaser shall indemnify and hold harmless the University from and against any liability whatsoever for personal injury or property damage occurring at Humphrey Coliseum, including the club seating.



PROCEDURES

HUMPHREY COLISEUM ENTRY PROCEDURES

- The Courtside Club has a designated entrance for members and guests located on the north side of the coliseum across from Dudy Noble Field. However, any valid entrance to enter the coliseum may be used.
- All members and guests are expected to comply with the clear bag policy.
 This policy can be found on page 6.
- Members and guests who leave the coliseum will not be allowed re-entry without an unused ticket.

TICKETS

- The Bulldog Club handles all billing and distribution of tickets and parking passes. All questions regarding club membership may be directed to the Bulldog Club Office. Please call 662.325.3074 for assistance regarding these issues.
- Should a club member misplace a game ticket on non-game days, please
 contact the Ticket Office at 662.325.2600 for a reprint. If tickets are misplaced
 on game day, please visit the Humphrey Coliseum Ticket Office window located
 on the east side of the coliseum for a reprint. The Ticket Office window will
 open sixty (60) minutes prior to tip-off.

CLUB AMENITIES

- Televisions throughout the club area.
- Complimentary food and non-alcoholic beverages available through the end of the game.
- Bar with beer, wine, canned cocktails, and spirits available for purchase.
- Soft seating throughout the club area.
- Private restrooms for club members and guests.

CLUB ADMISSION POLICIES & GUIDELINES

- Admission to the Courtside Club requires a Courtside Club ticket. This ticket
 permits members and guests to travel freely in the Courtside Club. Everyone,
 regardless of age, is required to present a valid ticket to gain admission into
 the Courtside Club.
- All Courtside Club members will be required to scan their ticket upon entering Humphrey Coliseum and Bulldog Suites FANGINEER™ staff will be positioned outside of the club entrance to validate each ticket again and affix a wristband. Wristbands must be worn at all times. Please do not remove the wristband as a replacement will not be provided. Any member or guest without the appropriate wristband or credential in the club will be asked to leave.
- All members and guests will be asked to show their wristband when re-entering the club from their seats.
- Courtside Club members and guests will be allowed entry into the coliseum and club area sixty (60) minutes prior to tip-off. The club will close thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the game.



PROCEDURES CONT.

CLUB ADMISSION POLICIES & GUIDELINES

- To maintain a pleasant environment for all members and guests, we ask that all members and guests adhere to the following guidelines:
 - Members and guests are expected to respect the rights of other members and guests and ensure that all activities in the club area are conducted in a thoughtful and courteous manner.
 - Members and guests are asked to be mindful of others and limit the amount of time spent at the lounge seating, especially during high-volume times such as pre-game and halftime.
 - Members and guests are expected to be able to provide adequate supervision of their children at all times.
- Club members will continue to have access to the Frank and Paige Harrison Legends Club.
- The countertop seating overlooking the court in the Legends Club is not open seating. Please do not remove seats from this area. These seats are ticketed seats and have been purchased by club level members as their game day ticketed seat.
- Members and guests are allowed to leave the club area and return with the
 understanding that a ticket and wristband must be shown to re-enter the club
 area. Please note: Wristbands that are torn or not properly affixed will not be
 valid for re-entry into the club area.

COURTSIDE CLUB ACCESS FROM COURTSIDE SEATS

- The Courtside Club can be accessed from your courtside seat via the ramp located behind the north goal.
- Members and guests may access the Courtside Club freely during pregame until the announcement of starting lineups, halftime and timeouts.

LEGENDS CLUB ACCESS FROM COURTSIDE SEATS

- During the game, members and guests are allowed to access the Legends Club area via the baseline and take the steps located at sections 104/C105 & sections C107/108.
- Members and guests may access the Legends Club freely during pregame until
 the announcement of starting lineups, halftime and timeouts.



PROCEDURES CONT.

SERVICES

- FANGINEERS™:
 - FANGINEERS™ (game day hospitality staff) are extensions of the Bulldog Suites staff and serve as liaisons between the Bulldog Suites Office, Bulldog Club and Athletics Department personnel, club members, catering staff, and cleaning/ maintenance staff.
 - FANGINEERS™ will be responsible for greeting and directing members' and guests' entry, as well as validating tickets and credentials and issuing wristbands.
- In-Seat Service:
 - Bulldog Suites gladly provides convenient, personalized in-seat service beginning when gates open and continuing through the end of the game.
 Dedicated FANGINEER™ staff are available to take and deliver orders directly to your seat, including a selection of food, non-alcoholic and alcoholic beverages.
 All alcoholic beverage service follows the same policies outlined for the club areas (see page 8 for details).
 - As you arrive, designated FANGINEERS[™] will greet you and share the in-seat service menu along with instructions for ordering.
- Cleaning and Maintenance:
 - If a member or guest encounters a cleaning and/or maintenance need, they
 may contact a Bulldog Suites FANGINEER™ in the club area.

CLEAR BAG POLICY

- Members and guests are asked to adhere to the Humphrey Coliseum Clear Bag Policy. The following guidelines outline bags that are permitted into Humphrey Coliseum:
 - Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12".
 - One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag.
 - Small clutch purse, with or without a strap or handle that does not exceed 4.5° x 6.5° .
 - An exception for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a designated entrance.

- Alcoholic beverages
- Smoking in all areas
- Weapons
- Pistols
- Revolvers
- Fireworks
- Pets
- Non-approved banners and signs
- Outside food and beverage
- Bicycles
- Any illegal substances
- Balls and frisbees
- Radios without headsets
- Professional cameras

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Club members and their guests will have access to an all-inclusive buffet
presentation in the club area. All food items will be available when gates open
until the end of halftime. Tailgate items, snacks and non-alcoholic beverages

for club members and their guests until the end of the third (3rd) quarter.
Members and guests will be allowed to purchase two beverages per
