The City of Tuscaloosa Historic Preservation Commission will hold a public hearing in the Council Chamber of City Hall at 2201 University Boulevard at 5:00 p.m., on Wednesday, the 11th day of February 2026. You are welcome to attend the meeting in person and speak during the public hearing by joining us in the Council Chambers at City Hall. We recommend arriving on time for the meeting, as agendas move at an unpredictable pace. Access to the public hearing will end by 7:00 p.m. if the meeting has not concluded prior to then. Parking is available in the parking deck located at 601 23rd Avenue, at the corner of 23rd Avenue and 7th Street. Enter City Hall through the entrance at the top level of the parking deck.
