

## **ORDINANCE NO. 1970**

### **AN ORDINANCE TO NAME THAT UNNAMED ROAD LOCATED IN THE NORTH ONE HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 18, RANGE 5, SOUTH OF THE SOUTHERN RAILROAD TRACK IN THE CITY OF TALLADEGA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Talladega is authorized to maintain and control the public streets in the City of Talladega; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Talladega has been notified by Talladega County Emergency Management Communications District (“E-911”) that there is a road located in the North one half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 18, Range 5, running east and west parallel to the Southern Railroad track and South of the Southern Railroad track that is designated on the E-911 map as an unnamed road and on the tax plat maintained by the office of the Revenue Commissioner of Talladega County as Broome Street East, which is a duplication of the name that is assigned to that road located on the north side of the Southern Railroad track; and,

**WHEREAS**, a parcel located at the western end of said unnamed road is designated as Hill Street and is totally inaccessible from Hill Street; and,

**WHEREAS**, the use of the name Broome Street East for the street located on the north side of the Southern Railroad track and the south side of the Southern Railroad track creates confusion for dispatching emergency calls by E- 911; and,

**WHEREAS**, E- 911 has requested the City Council to assign a name to the unnamed road;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

#### **SECTION 1: NAMING OF UNNAMED STREET**

That street located in the North one half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 18, Range 5, located south of the Southern Railroad track and running parallel to said railroad track, commencing at a point on the south side of that section of Broome Street located on the north side of the Southern Railroad track, West of Stephen J. White Memorial Boulevard, running south from Broome Street East to a point and then running West to its ending point is named and shall hereinafter be known as “**Broome Place.**”

#### **SECTION 2: IMPLEMENTATION**

The City Manager or his designee shall erect or cause to be erected appropriate signage indicating the name of the street. The City Clerk shall notify all relevant government agencies of the naming of said street.

#### **SECTION 3: FUNDING**

The cost of installation and maintenance of the street name signed shall be covered by the City’s allocated budget for traffic safety improvements. The Finance Department is authorized to allocate the necessary funds for this purpose.

#### **SECTION 5: MAINTENANCE**

The Community Service Department shall be responsible for the ongoing maintenance and repair of the street sign.

#### **SECTION 6: SEVERABILITY**

If any section, subsection or provision of the Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by judgment or decree by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment or decree shall not affect any other section, subsection or provision of this ordinance.

#### **SECTION 7: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 8: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
