



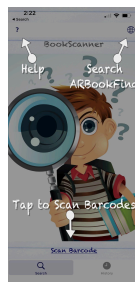
Lower School Summer Reading

Rising 1st graders

Rising First Graders **DO NOT** take AR tests. They keep a log of what they have read, or what has been read to them. They should read, or have read to them, at least 3 books over the summer. Use the **Reading Log** at the bottom or create your own.

Rising 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grader

1. Each student should read 3 books in his/her reading range or grade level, and take an **Accelerated Reader** test on each book. If your book is not an **AR** book, then write a brief summary of the book. Be careful to use correct grammar and sentence structure.
2. Check the **BOOKS NOT TO READ** list at the bottom of the page. These books will be read in class.
3. **The school library will be open on Wednesdays beginning June 10-July 29th from 9:00-1:00, with the exception of July 8, the school will be closed.**
Parents are not allowed in the library during this time. There will be a faculty member there to help if needed.
4. How do you know if your book is an AR book or not? Download the BookScanner App and scan the barcode to find out.
