The City of Tuscaloosa Historic Preservation Commission will hold a public hearing in the Council Chamber of City Hall at 5:00 p.m., on Wednesday, the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 2026. You are welcome to attend the meeting in person and speak during the public hearing by joining us in the Council Chambers at City Hall. We recommend arriving on time for the meeting, as agendas move at an unpredictable pace. Access to the public hearing will end by 7:00 p.m. if the meeting has not concluded prior to then. Parking is available in the parking deck located at 2230 7<sup>th</sup> Street, at the corner of 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and 7<sup>th</sup> Street. Enter City Hall through the entrance at the top level of the parking deck.
