Created in honor of Ms. Flowers's lasting legacy and impact, the scholarship seeks to recognize, support, and celebrate the heritage, accomplishments, and potential of residents of Lowndes County. Priority consideration will be given to Lowndes County residents. Applicants may submit their completed scholarship application packets by email, mail, or hand delivery to the Financial Aid Office. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all required documentation is complete and submitted by the stated deadline. The scholarship committee will review all eligible application packets received on time to determine scholarship recipients, who will be notified in writing. Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline will not be considered unless an official extension is announced.

Required Documentation Checklist:

- Completed Application Form
- Official Academic Transcript (Must have a cumulative GPA of a 3.25 or higher)
- Typed Essay
- Letter of Acceptance from the 4-year Institution
- Two typed letters of recommendation from non-relatives

Essay Requirement:

- **Prompt:** Please describe your long-term professional aspirations and explain how transferring from a two-year institution to [Accepted University] will support your ability to contribute to your local community or state industry. In recognition of Ms. Flowers's enduring legacy and impact, this scholarship seeks to honor and uplift the heritage, achievements, and potential of students dedicated to academic excellence and community advancement. Additionally, discuss how you have maintained strong academic performance while effectively balancing personal, professional, or other responsibilities throughout your educational journey.
- **Format:** Double-spaced, 12pt font
- **Length:** 500 to 750 words
