The City of Tuscaloosa Historic Preservation Commission will hold a public hearing in the Council Chamber of City Hall at 5:00 p.m., on Wednesday, the 8th day of July 2026. We recommend arriving on time for the meeting, as agendas move at an unpredictable pace. Access to the public hearing will end by 7:00 p.m. if the meeting has not concluded prior to then.
