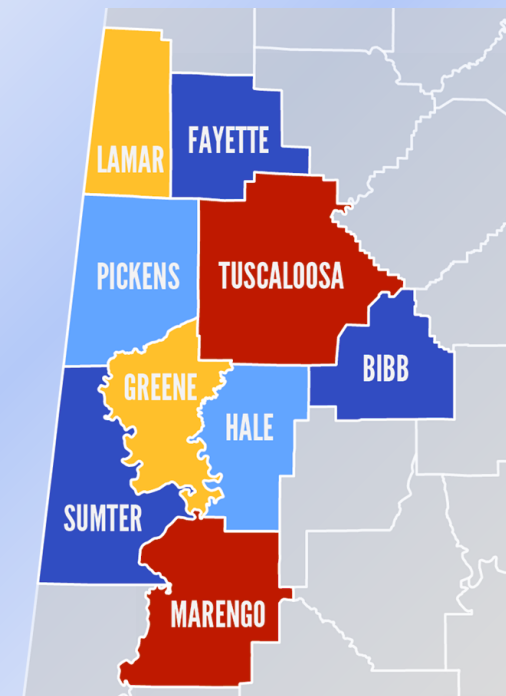

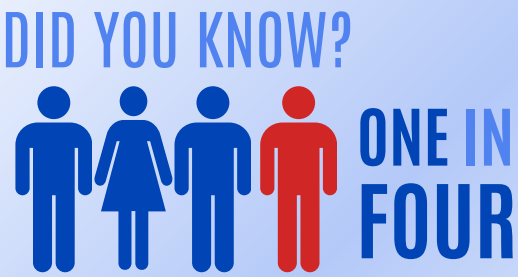

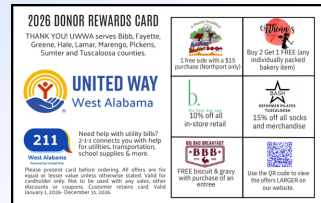

The Arc of Tuscaloosa County	Job skills training and placement for adults 21+	Pay for 10 round-trips on the Tuscaloosa Trolley for transportation to prevocational training & employment
Arts ‘n Autism	Provides autism services in Tuscaloosa and surrounding counties to children from preschool to young adults	Buy five canvases for art therapy class
Big Brothers Big Sisters of West AL	Screened volunteers provide one-on-one mentorship to at-risk children	Cover the cost of one Little to attend a movie or field trip with BBBS or a one-on-one trip with their Big
Black Warrior Council, Scouting America	Citizenship, fitness & leadership opportunities for children	Provide supplies for a troop for a weekly meeting
Boys & Girls Clubs of West AL	Education, recreation, and leadership programs for children and youth	Cover the cost of a summer field trip for one child
Caring Days Adult Day Care	Day care for adults with Alzheimer’s, Parkinson’s & other forms of memory disorders	Provide art supplies like ink, pens/pencils, paint brushes and water color paper
Catholic Social Services	Food, clothing, prescriptions & financial assistance to community members in need	Provide canned goods for a family of four for a week
Child Abuse Prevention Services	Provides education for children, parents & the community-at-large to prevent child abuse and neglect	Buy crib sheets for parents in the Nurturing Baby/ Safe Sleep program
Children of the Village Network, Inc.	Resources for Sumter County including early childhood education, afterschool programs & meals for seniors	Purchase books for school-aged children
Easterseals West Alabama	Provides assistance and transportation to children and adults with physical disabilities	Buy books for children ages 2-5 in the Parents as Teachers program
Family Counseling Service	Counseling for individuals and families	Provide a therapeutic toy for use in play therapy
Five Horizons Health Services	Provides medical care, prevention education & supportive services to people at risk for or living with HIV or other STIs	Purchase non-perishables for Five Horizon’s Food Bank
FOCUS 50+	Programs and services for senior citizens	Buy two round trips for medical & shopping purposes for a senior in need
Girl Scouts of North-Central AL	Educational and recreational programs for girls	Purchase a Girl Scout membership & association pin
Good Samaritan Clinic	Provides primary health care to the uninsured with incomes at or below federal poverty guidelines	Buy a 90-day supply of medication for a patient
Hospice of West Alabama	Professional health care support for the terminally ill, either inpatient or at-home care	Purchase various steroid, pain, stomach reflux & antihistamine medications
Phoenix House	Halfway house for drug and alcohol dependent men & women	Purchase a client’s personal hygiene products
Salvation Army	Emergency food and lodging for the unhoused	Provide a meal for a family of five
Sickle Cell Disease Assn of West AL	Improves the health status of families affected by sickle cell disease & other hemoglobin disorders	Provide a two-month supply of antibiotics to an infant with sickle cell
Temporary Emergency Services	Help to those in need, including food, clothing, mobile showers, laundry units, & emergency services	Buy personal hygiene items like feminine products, soap, toothpaste, etc.
Theo Ratliff Activity Center	Resources for Marengo County including afterschool programs, adult & senior programs, & workforce development	Provides school supplies for after school program
Turning Point	Safe shelter & counseling for abuse victims & their families	Provide a personal kit that is given to clients upon their arrival at the shelter
Tuscaloosa SAFE Center	24/7 sexual assault crisis center	Provides a sexual assault victim with new clothing when his/hers are taken for evidence
Tuscaloosa’s One Place	Support services to families & helps develop skills & resources to improve a family’s quality of life	Purchase school supplies for children in the after-school program
UCP United	Provides services to persons with special abilities	Support a lunch date for one of our clients
YMCA of Tuscaloosa County	Youth, adult & family athletics & wellness programs	After-school supplies for one child for a 9-week period
