AMENDMENT #13 TO THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S 2012 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN

The City of Tuscaloosa desires to make the following substantial amendments to the 2012 Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan that was previously approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). - 3. Adjusting Reallocated Program Income Funds for anticipated program income interest to \$1,095,372.10.
