

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-07

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING INDUSTRIAL DRIVE
IN THE CITY OF MOUNDVILLE.**

WHEREAS, the owners an easement which has been dedicated as a road known as Industrial Drive have deeded the right-of-way to the City and have requested that the City of Moundville accept the dedication of the easement as described in the deed of conveyance as a public street, and to assume responsibility for the maintenance for the portion accepted; and

WHEREAS, the said right-of-way has been used as a public road, but has not been formally dedicated to public use.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNDVILLE, ALABAMA:

SECTION 1: That the City of Moundville, Alabama hereby accepts the dedication of the public right-of-way known as Industrial Drive to the extent described in the deed of conveyance, located within the City of Moundville.


SECTION 2: That all ordinances of parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
