The City Council of the City of Oxford, Alabama, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber in the City Hall of the City of Oxford, Alabama, on Tuesday, May 26, 2020, at approximately 6:30 o'clock p.m. Council President Spurlin called the meeting to order.

Ron Allen, City Attorney, was present.

Alan Atkinson, City Clerk, was present.

Chief Sparks prayed the Invocation.

Council President Spurlin led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ordinance No. 2020- 13 – Ordinance amending Chapter 14, Section 14.4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Oxford; Open Burning Standards

Council Member Gardner made a motion for the unanimous consent of the Council for the immediate consideration of Ordinance Number 2020-13. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hubbard; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Gardner, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none. The motion carried.

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Unanimous consent of the Council having been given for the immediate consideration of Ordinance Number 2020-13, Council Member Gardner made a motion to approve Ordinance Number 2020-13. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hubbard; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Gardner, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none. The motion carried and Ordinance Number 2020-13 was approved.

Ordinance No. 2020- 14 – Ordinance declaring certain real property owned by the City as surplus and authorizing its sale to Holmes and Holmes Holdings in the total amount of \$108,999.59

Council Member Henderson made a motion for the unanimous consent of the Council for the immediate consideration of Ordinance Number 2020-14. The motion was seconded by Council Member Gardner; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Gardner, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none. Resolution No. 2020 – 50 – Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with the Alabama Firefighters’ Personnel Standards and Education Commission for recruit training at an Oxford Fire Department facility.

Council Member Waits made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, Resolution Numbers 2020-49 through 2020-50. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hubbard; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Hubbard, Gardner, Waits, Henderson and Spurlin; nays: none. The motion carried and the Consent Agenda, Resolution Numbers 2020-49 through 2020-50, were approved.

Council President Spurlin stated he appreciated the efforts made by the Oxford School System to have graduation services for the students.

Mayor Craft stated that all the tennis courts had been resurfaced. He stated they were working with Kevin Greene for a date for the splash park to reopen.


There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Henderson made a motion to adjourn. Council President Spurlin declared the meeting adjourned at approximately 6:36 o’clock p.m.
