2.	Recognize how	the sins of the tongue are to us.

3.	Recognize that	power cannot tame the tongue.
4.	Recognize that we will sometimes	in our speech.
	"But I tell you that every careless word that people judgment. ³⁷ For by your words you will be justified,	speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of and by your words you will be condemned." Matthew 12:36-37
5.	Recognize that our	reveals the true condition of our hearts.
	Doing the Word:	

- Work first on our hearts, then on our speech the closer we are to Jesus, the sweeter our words will be.
- Be quick to repent when we sin in our speech.
- Be quick to forgive when we are sinned against.
- Be especially careful with typed or posted words.
- When we stumble, we fix our eyes on Jesus, repent of our sins, and trust Him as we move forward in victory.
